Please note that CSA approved hockey helmets are now mandatory for all Can-Skate skaters. Please insure that skaters are dressed appropriately with warm clothing and mittens. Skates should fit properly and should be sharpened before the beginning of the season. Normally skates should be re-sharpened every 10 weeks. It is highly recommended that parents stay at the arena.

Several times through the season we will be having a CanSkate FUN DAY. This may involve wearing a funny hat, a beach shirt and sun glasses, or simply playing some games. Please watch posters, handouts and the newsletter for further information.
