What is the Ice Show?

An Ice Show is a theatrical show on ice complete with costumes, music and choreography! Most skating clubs have one either annually or bi-annually. Our Ice Show is bi-annual. Amateur Ice Shows showcase the talents of all its skaters for an audience that includes a large proportion of immediate family members and friends.

Every skater is eligible to participate - you just have to register.

Costs

Ice Shows are extremely expensive to produce and Ice Show costs are not included in the price of your regular membership since participation is optional but strongly encouraged. Your Ice Show registration fee helps defray the cost of:

- Facilities. The entire Stouffville Arena is usually rented for most of the Ice show week to install curtains, lights, music, etc.
- Ice rental fees.
- Rental of costumes.
- Coaches and Director fees
- Lighting - a fee applies to bring in an outside lighting crew and lighting
- Music - a rental sound system
- Ticket Printing and the assorted running costs
