# Stouffville Skating Club Covid-19 Protocols



## **DAILY ROUTINE SCREENING**

- Club and skating school members must follow all public health guidelines regarding Covid-19.
- Any club/skating member who has travelled outside of Canada, or has someone in their household
  who has travelled outside of Canada must self-isolate and not participate in club/skating school activities for 14 days.
- Any individual who has been exposed to someone with a confirmed case of Covid-19 should selfisolate and is not permitted to participate in club/skating school activities for 14 days.
- Any individual, or someone in their household, with symptoms of Covid-19 is not permitted to take part in club/skating school activities.

### **ARRIVAL PROCEDURES**

- All skaters and parents/quardians are asked to wash or sanitize their hands upon arrival.
- All skaters and parent/guardians are responsible to follow social distancing guidelines both on ice and off ice.
- All skaters and parents/guardians are required to wear masks upon entry to the arena. Skaters
  are NOT required to wear masks while skating.
- Attendance will be taken for all skaters, parent/guardians and coaches for contact tracing if required.
- Skaters must arrive fully dressed (with the exception of skates and helmets). Skaters should leave skating bags and personal items in their individual vehicle if available.
- Dressing rooms will NOT be available for use.
- Skaters should arrive no more than fifteen (15) minutes prior to their scheduled ice time and leave within ten (10) minutes at the conclusion of their ice time.
- Participants are asked to enter the arena through the East entry door (near the elevators) and proceed directly to their rink.
- Skaters are asked to sit in one of the chairs provided to put on their skates. All personal belongings are to remain on the chair. Skaters are asked to keep chairs in their designated area for social distancing. Once off the ice, skaters are to use the same chair to remove their skates. The skating rink staff will clean and sanitize seats in between sessions.
- Skaters must remain at least 2m apart from any other individual (not in their household) while waiting to enter and exit the ice.
- Only ONE spectator may sit in the viewing area, maintaining social distancing and wearing a mask at all times.
- Public washrooms will be available adjacent to the viewing area.

# IF AN INDIVUAL PRESENTS WITH SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19

- If an individual becomes unwell with symptoms of Covid-19 they must immediately stop participation in the club/skating school activities.
- The individual will be isolated for all others until they can be taken home.
- The individual must follow public health guidelines regarding self-isolation and testing.
- The club/skating school will work with public health to consults the session attendance sheets to inform other club/skating school members who may have been in close contact with the individual. Close contact is defined at being within 2m for a period lasting more than 15 minutes without appropriate or consistent use of personal protective equipment (masks).
- Any club/skating school member who were in close contact with the individual should not participate in club/skating school activities and should follow public health guidelines until the diagnosis of Covid-19 is ruled out by health professionals.
